ALASKA TROPHY ADVENTURES LODGE Opening Weeks 2023

I'm excited to be returning to Alaska Trophy Adventures Lodge for the opening weeks of the Alaskan fishing season in 2023. Join me for a hosted week of fishing with author Steve Ramirez as our distinguished guest.

The first full week of lodge operation is Sunday to Sunday, June 11 to 18, but the opening day of the Alaska fishing season is June 8. This provides fishermen and women with several trip options:

June 7-11

Arrive with me at ATA Lodge on June 7, fish June 8-10, and depart on June 11. If you have a busy schedule, this short week is the perfect get-away. You'll fish for completely rested and unmolested rainbow trout and arctic grayling. Join me for some of the best mouse fishing that I've ever experienced! The cost of this short week is \$3,995*.

June 11-18

The first full week of the season! Join Steve and me at ATA Lodge when you arrive on June 11, fish June 12-17, and depart on June 18. If you'd like to join us for the first full week, the price is \$6800^{*}.

June 7-18

The best of both! Arrive with me at ATA Lodge on June 7, fish June 8-17 (ten full days of fishing!), and depart on June 18. The cost of the extended week is \$7,995*. Get three extra days of fishing for just \$1,195.00.

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Tuesday, June 6 or Saturday, June 10 Arrive in Anchorage and spend the night.

Wednesday, June 7 or Sunday, June 11

Fly from Anchorage to King Salmon. Anchorage to King Salmon flight details will be provided when the schedules have been set.

On arrival in King Salmon, an ATA rep will meet you and take you to the air charter (DHC Beaver on wheels). Due to limited space you will fly to the lodge in several groups.

When you arrive at the lodge the staff will show you to your cabin. You will meet the staff and guides and enjoy a pleasant evening and dinner.

Thursday, June 8 - Saturday, June 10 (three days) Monday June 12 - Saturday, June 17 (six days) Thursday, June 8 - Saturday, June 17 (ten days)

We will fish and enjoy the Alaskan experience. Hearty breakfasts at the lodge, lunches on the river, return to the lodge in the evening for dinner and tall tales from the day. Lodge-based wildlife viewing and adventure activities are also possible

Sunday, June 11 or Sunday, June 18

Shuttle to King Salmon for return flight to Anchorage. King Salmon to Anchorage flight details will be provided when the schedules have been set.

Return home on an evening flight or enjoy Anchorage for a few days.

The Anchorage airport is easy to navigate, and there shouldn't be a problem making a connection if you have a late evening flight home on Sunday, June 11 or Sunday June 18.

DEPOSITS & REFUNDS

A 50% deposit is required at the time of booking your package with ATAL. The remainder is due 60 days before your arrival date. ATAL gives a 10-day grace period after booking, where deposits will be refunded in full minus \$200 admin fee. They are not able to refund any deposits after the 10-day grace period.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

As exciting as a trip to Alaska can be, you face the possibility that you or your fishing companion might be forced to cancel your trip at the last moment due to illness, injury or other emergencies before or during your trip.

We strongly suggest you get travel insurance when booking your trip. We recommend securing your trip with cancellation coverage through <u>Travel-Guard's Sportsmen Travel Insurance</u>. - Wading boots rubber soled felt soles are illegal in Alaska
